SHORT CURRICULUM VITAE

Panagiotis Prezerakos has graduated the Faculty of Nursing, University of Athens on 1992 and the MSc. Course in Health Services Management, University of London on 1995. He holds Ph.D from the Faculty of Nursing, University of Athens, since 2000, in the field of Health Services Management titled: "Efficiency of the Hellenic NHS Hospitals within Diagnosis Related Groups".

From 1989 has worked as a RN in ICU of the General Hospital of Chest Diseases of Athens "SOTIRIA" and since 1996 has been occupied as responsible for Life Long Learning activities for nursing personnel of the same hospital. During 1998-2001 has worked as the Scientific Director of the Vocational Training Center of the same hospital and since 2002 has been employed as Manager of the Kyparissia's General Hospital. During 2004-2006 held the position of Manager – General Director of 2nd Regional Health Authority of Attica (*which included 10 hospitals (3.670,00 beds), 8 Health Centers, 5 Units of Social Solidarity and the 1st Aid Station of the Athens International Airport*).

Since the academic year 2005-06 he was working at the Faculty of Nursing of the University of Peloponnese as Assistant Professor (PD 407/80), while he was responsible for the syllabi of courses of the Postgraduate Studies Programmes of the Universities of Peloponnese and Athens on Health Services Management. On July of 2009 was elected as an Assistant Professor of the Department of Nursing, University of Peloponnese, in the field of "Nursing Services Management-Modules of Nursing Care". At the present time holds the position of the Associate Professor in the same University.

More over during November 2009 till present is the Executive Vice President of the Hellenic Association of Health Services Management as well as member of relevant scientific and professional associations.

Since 1992 till nowadays has participated as a lecturer or coordinator in quite a lot (~125) of international and hellenic congresses. His research (23 *projects*) and writing (~50 *papers*) activities, during the same period, refer to the sector of Health Services Management, focused on Nursing Services.
